**Contest rules*

- The contest is open to schools within the Town of Queen Creek municipal boundaries.
- Art and written submissions must be confined to 8.5x11-inch paper and can be drawn, painted, mixed media, digital, or photography. Art must be two-dimensional only.
- Entries will be judged by the Town’s Downtown Arts and Placemaking Advisory Subcommittee based on originality and creativity - winners will be selected for both categories.
- Submissions must be received by the Town of Queen Creek at the Municipal Services Building at 22358 S. Ellsworth Road Queen Creek, AZ 85142, by Monday, Aug. 31 at 6 p.m. and must include this form with submission.
- Original artwork and written submissions ONLY. Entries must not infringe upon the trademark, copyright, moral rights, intellectual rights, or rights of privacy of any entity or person.
- By entering the contest, entrants agree that entry and name submitted can be used by the Town of Queen Creek for promotional purposes. Entries will not be returned.
- The Town of Queen Creek reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is deemed inappropriate or does not conform to stated contest rules.
- Winners will be announced at the Sept. 16 Town Council meeting.
- Prizes will be provided to top entries by local businesses.
- Space permitting, winner of patriotic poem will be invited to share their poem at the Constitution Week Community Celebration (date/time TBD) and art entries displayed at the Founders’ Day event on Sept. 19.
